WE INVEST IN PEOPLE

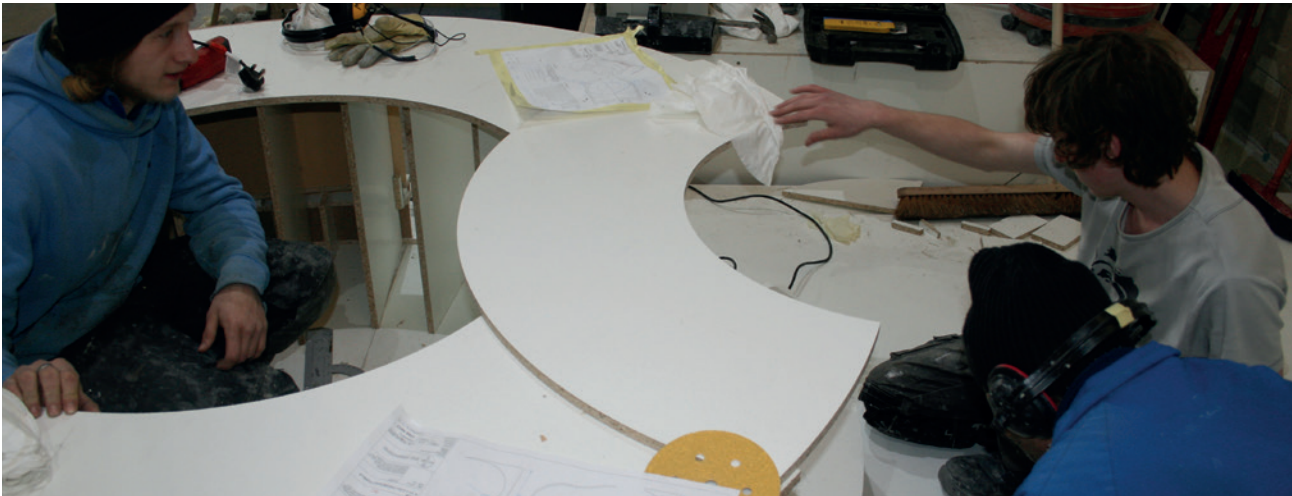


We at GMT are great believers in giving opportunities to young people in the local community. We have employed school leavers from local comprehensive schools.

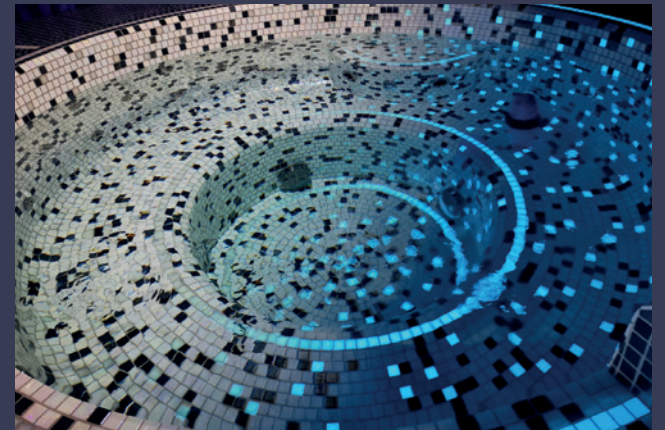
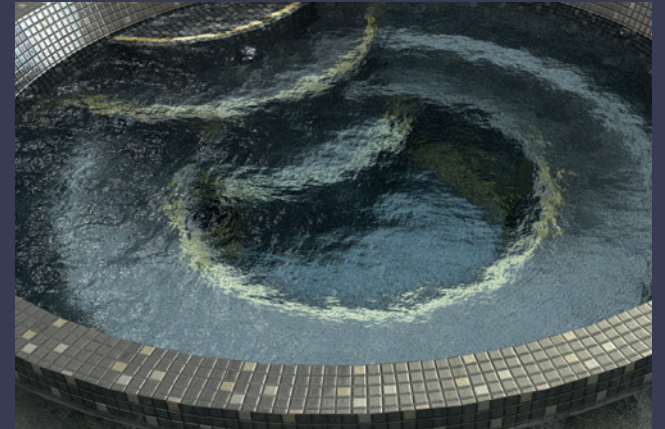
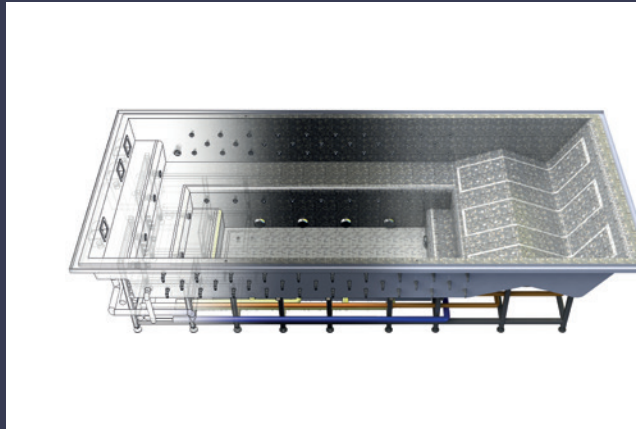
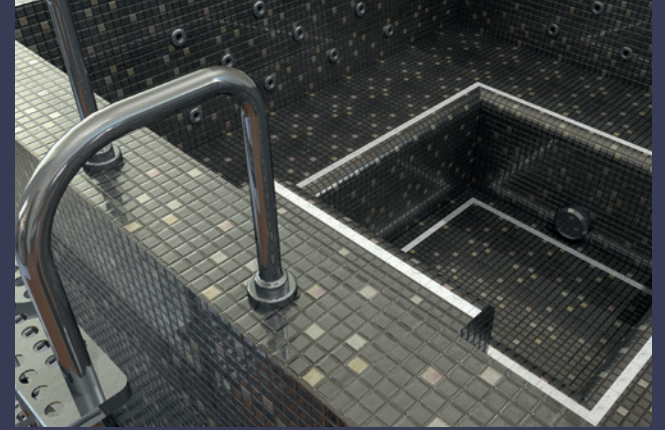
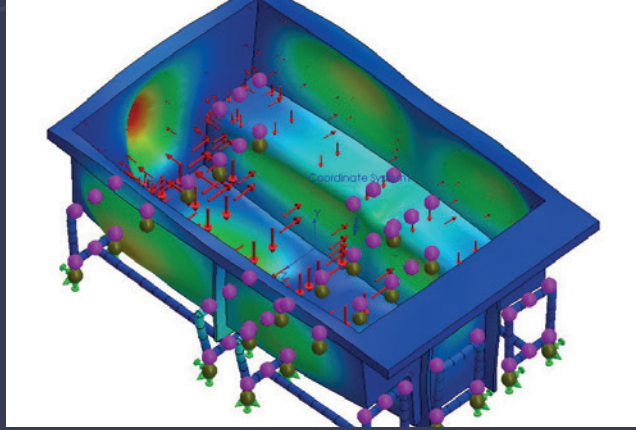
QUALITY OF DESIGN

We work closely with designers, architects, pool installers and end users merging our extensive knowledge and their vision to produce bespoke luxurious spas, swim spas and hydrotherapy pools to fulfil the needs of the most exacting clients.

We have been involved in many award-winning and elaborate projects. Our drawing and design team uses the latest 3D modelling software to design and produce working drawings and 3D visuals for our clients.

We also use Finite Element Analysis (FEA) a stress testing program which enables us to test the integrity of the pool before it goes into production, eliminating problems such as excess deflection and pressure on surrounding structures, particularly useful on yacht, balcony or rooftop projects. Also, by using FEA the life of the pool is prolonged due to the exacting design.



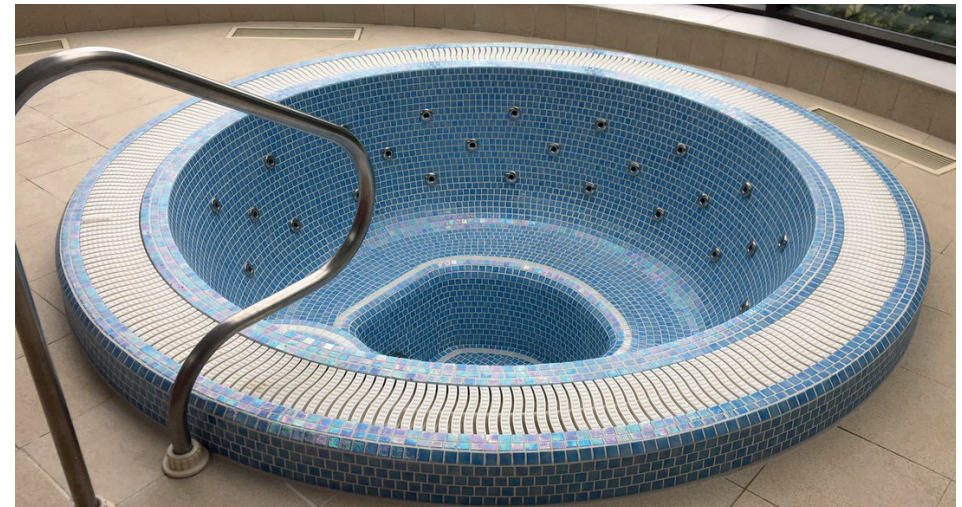
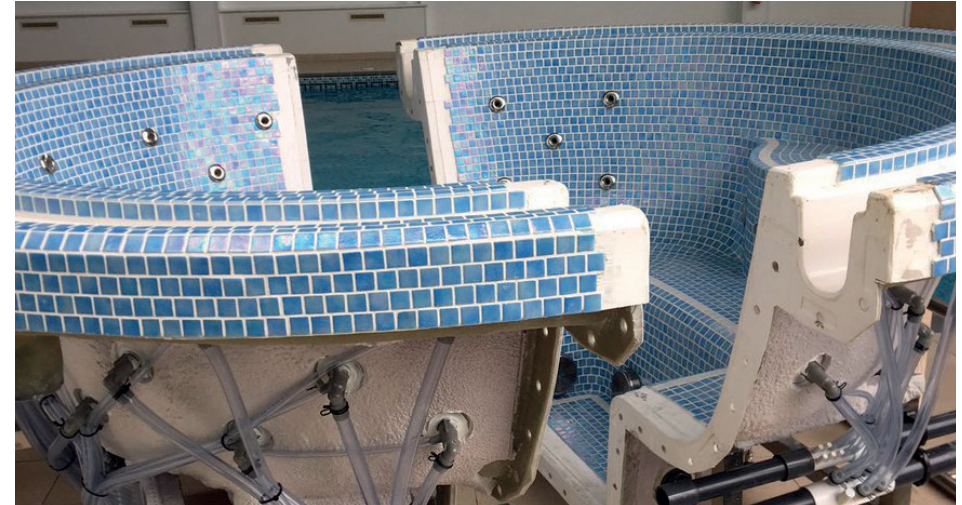


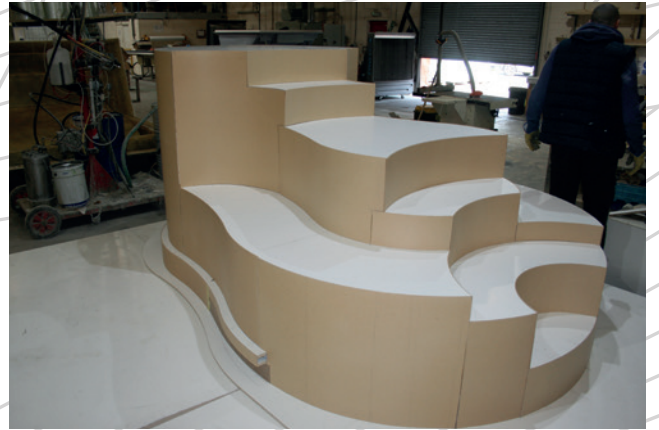
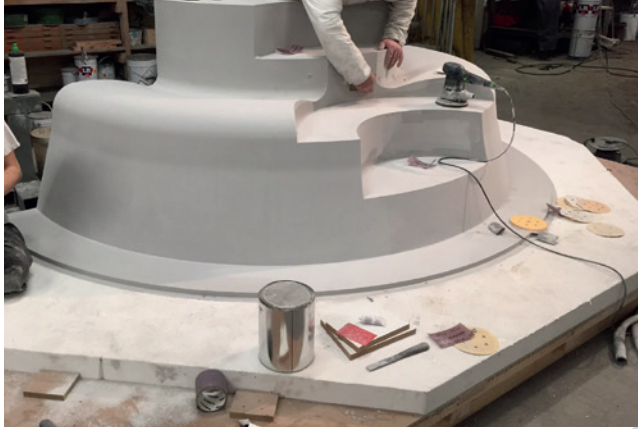
QUALITY OF MANUFACTURE

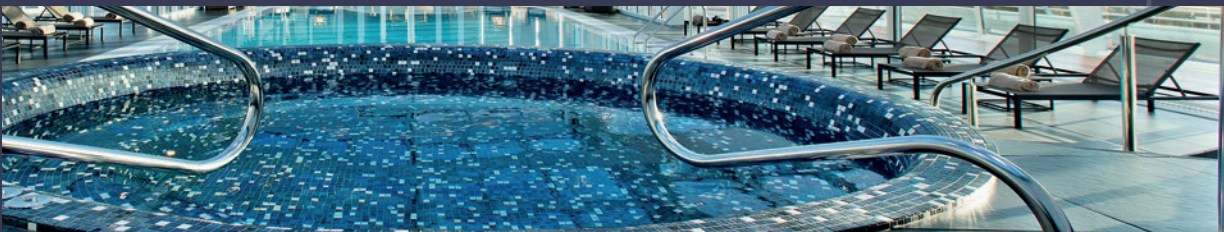


BESPOKE SPAS

If our extensive range of standard spas don't meet your specification in terms of space or features, our team will use their expertise to create a bespoke spa experience for you.

The overall size, type/position of access, and even the layout of the features can all be customised. Every detail and dimension can be altered to meet your needed. If you prefer a fully submerged experience then the seats can be lower, if you have a view you want to accentuate then overflows can be lowered creating an infinity edge for the water to cascade over.

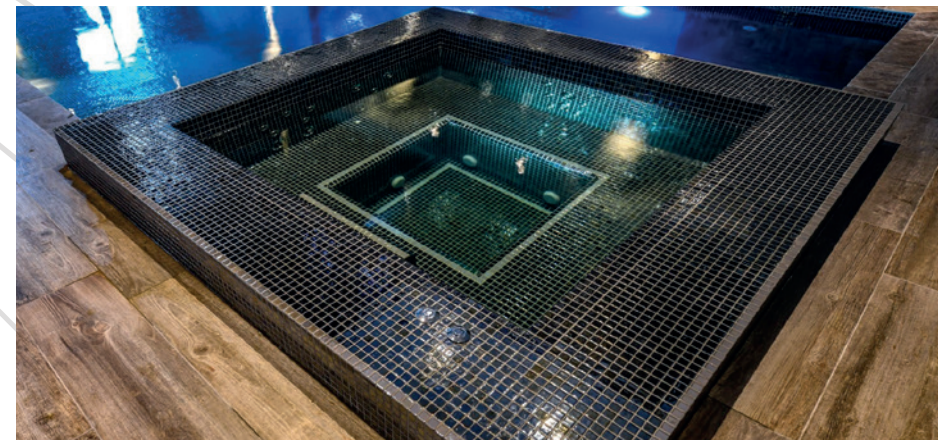
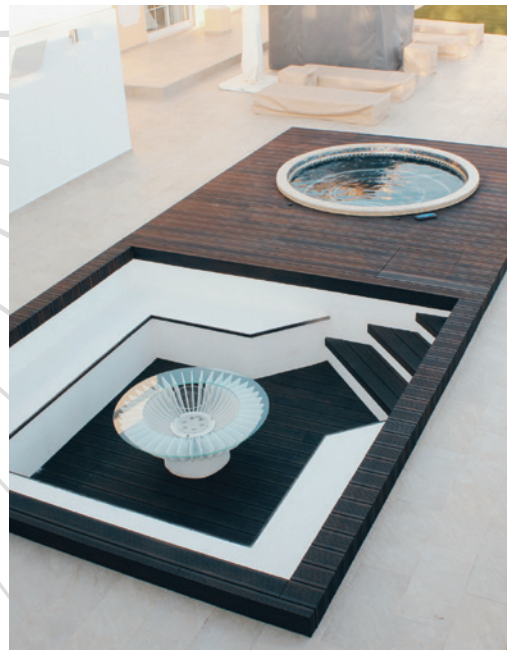
If the access to the position of the spa would limit the size of the spa that can be installed then we can manufacture the spa in multiple sections, which will then be joined and sealed in position by our team and finished in the same way as the rest of the spa ensuring there is no sign of a joint.



FREEBOARD SPAS

A Freeboard spa is an enclosed pool system where the water level is below the top edge of the spa.

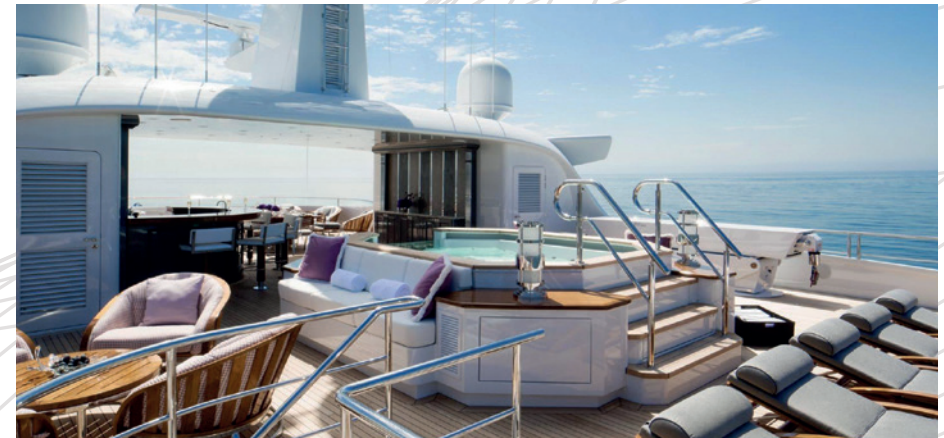
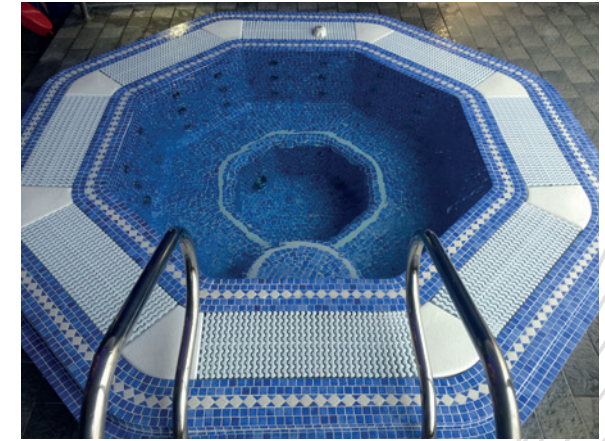
The water level increases or decreases with the bather load. The water is cleaned via filtration, suctions, and skimmers. There is no need for a balance tank which makes it suitable for domestic and commercial settings or restricted spaces.



DECK LEVEL SPAS

The water in a deck level spa constantly sits level with the surrounding channel which sits flush with the finished floor.

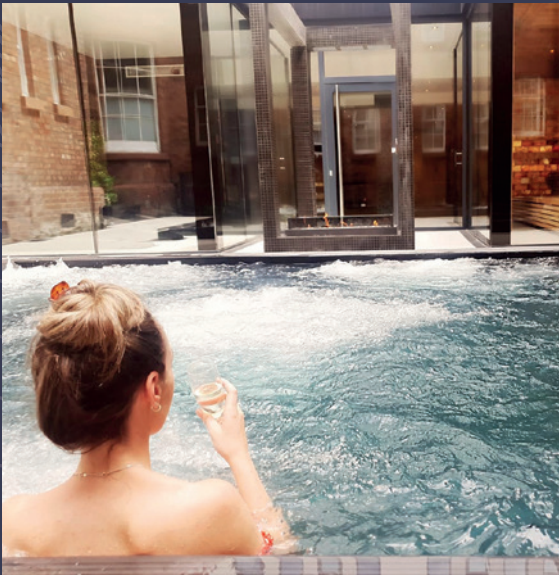
Water continually overflows from the spa into the channel at a rate commensurate with the bather load. A balance tank is required to take the displaced water. This style is ideal for commercial applications as they allow for higher turnover rates. If space is of a premium a unique overflow channel can be made negating the need for a balance tank.



INFINITY SPAS

These spas are like deck level spas. One or all of the channels sit lower than the water level, giving a cascade effect, they are particularly useful if a fully in-ground spa is not an option.

A balance tank is required to hold the displaced water. This style is ideal for outdoor spas to create a seamless connection between the water and the view.



VITALITY SPAS

Vitality or Hydrotherapy spas can be freeboard, deck level or Infinity. Incorporating multiple levels allows for standing, lounging or sitting.

Volcano pads, calf and feet massage jets and bubble pads on loungers are some of the many features to choose from. Jets stations can be tailored to suite the client. Often coloured lights both in the pool and in the pool room along with soothing music are added.

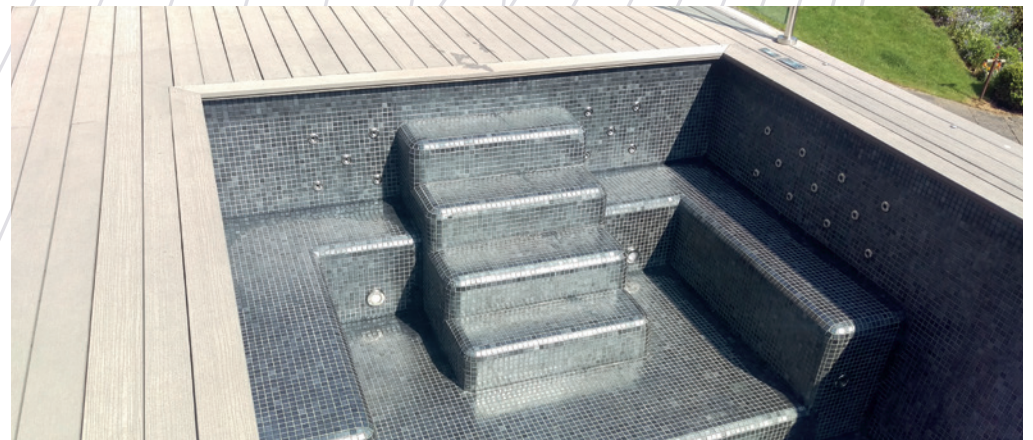
Hydrotherapy, formerly called hydropathy or also called water cure, is a part of alternative medicine, occupational therapy, and physiotherapy that involves the use of water for pain relief and treatment. It gives emotional and psychological benefits, including a sense of calm, emotional relaxation, and stress relief. Hydrotherapy is appropriate for all ages (from the youngest children to golden-agers) in treating back pain, slipped disk, issues of skeletal or muscular degeneration, fibromyalgia, Parkinson's, migraines, post-trauma stress and more. The physical wellness benefits of spa pools are delivered in three ways: heat increases circulation by dilating blood vessels, buoyancy relieves joint stress by reducing your weight by 90%, and powerful jets soothe away tension with massage. All these elements work together to provide a variety of health benefits that ultimately allow you to lead more active and fulfilled lives.



SWIM SPAS

Swim spas can be freeboard or deck level, they incorporate counter current exercise units which provide a powerful current.

Enabling the bather to swim for long periods without the need for a full-sized swimming pool. Swim spas can also have relaxation zones, seats and loungers as in a regular spa.



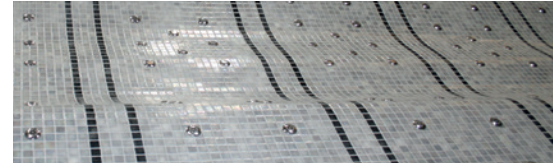
TILE, JETS & FEATURES

Once the size of the spa has been decided there are many more ways to personalise the look and experience. Our spas can be finished with an endless selection of mosaic tiles to complement the surroundings.

The design can be enhanced further using demarcation tiles to accent features of the spa such as the seats, steps, loungers etc. The spa structure can be reinforced to support large coping stones and even larger format tiling if this matches the design aesthetic.

To make the most of the experience our standard spas come with many massage jets installed. This can also be customised to your liking by having individual body stations of jets, using different sized adjustable jets in a variety of layouts, making each body station feel different and maximising the hydrotherapy benefits.

In addition to massage jets, larger spas can incorporate many other features including loungers, volcano pads, steel body stations, water cannons and lights to name a few.



COVER & BALANCE TANKS

Cover tanks are small tanks built into the spa to allow a floating roller cover to be stored while the spa is in use. Once the spa is no longer in use the cover will then extend over the spa water creating an insulating barrier making the running of the spa more efficient and cost effective.

Cover can also give an additional level of safety for people falling into the spa. The cover can be finished in the same way as the spa meaning the only evidence of the tank is the envelope slot in the side of the spa. In some instances we have also installed the cover tanks underneath the spa instead of their usual positions adjacent to the spa.

The purpose of a balance tank is to hold the water displaced by the bather or bathers, once the bathers leave the spa the water held in the balance tank then returns to the spa. The size of the balance tank relates to the capacity of the spa. The balance tank can be made in any shape, manufactured in sections and joined together on site, ideal if space is of a premium.



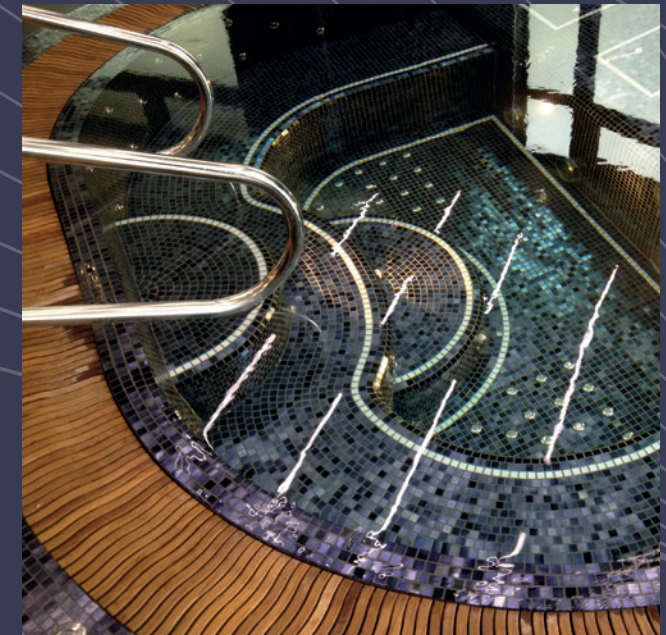
